**SPEAKER JONES ANNOUNCES NEW LEADERSHIP
APPOINTMENTS**

ANNAPOLIS, MD – House Speaker Adrienne A. Jones today announced changes to leadership positions for the 2023 legislative session.

Speaker Jones announced that **Delegate Marc Korman (Montgomery County, District 16)** will be the **House Majority Leader**. Stepping in to the third most-powerful position in the Maryland House of Delegates, Delegate Korman will lead the debate for the Democratic Party on the House floor.

“Marc is the right choice for House Majority Leader,” said Speaker Jones. “He is smart, persuasive and has a track record of bringing delegates together to get tough bills passed.”

Delegate Korman has been a member of the House of Delegates since 2015.

Speaker Jones also named **Delegate Jazz Lewis (Prince George's County, District 24)** as **House Majority Whip**. Delegate Lewis has been a member of the House of Delegates since 2017. “Jazz has done a remarkable job bringing our members together as Caucus Chair,” said Speaker Jones. “He’s a respected leader in the chamber and a natural fit to make sure our members are on the same page as it relates to the challenges and opportunities over the next four years.”

Delegate Emily Shetty (Montgomery County, District 18) was appointed **Chair of the House Democratic Caucus**. Delegate Shetty has served in the House since 2019. “Emily is someone who quickly gained the trust of her Democratic Caucus colleagues,” said Speaker Jones. “She’s clearly ready to take the reins of the caucus operation and build on our successes.”
